

Jan Wouters, born 1960, obtained a Master and PhD in physics from the University of Leuven, KU Leuven, Belgium, in 1982 and 1989, respectively, with intermission for officer military service. From 1989 till 1992 he was a Postdoc Research Fellow with the National Fund for Scientific Research (FWO) at the Institute of Nuclear Physics (UCL Louvain-la-Neuve) and at NASA Goddard Space Flight Center (USA). Since 1993 he is a Professor at the Dept. of Neurosciences of the KU Leuven (Full Professor since 2005) where he teaches 5 physics and audiology courses. His research focuses on audiology, the auditory system and auditory prostheses. He is author of about 240 articles in international peer-reviewed journals, associate editor of 3 international journals, president of the European Federation of Audiology Societies, and president of the Belgian Audiology Society B-Audio.
